Prof. Dr. Ummu Salma Bava is Professor of European Studies and Jean Monnet Chair in the [EU, Security, Peace and Conflict Resolution \(EU-SPCR\)](#). She was Chairperson, Centre for European Studies (November 2017- November 2019 and July 2009 - July 2011), School of International Studies; Director, UGC Europe Area Studies Programme (November 2011- March 2014) and Director, Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Advanced Studies (December 2012 – December 2014), Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India. She was also a guest faculty at the Foreign Service Institute, Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

With over thirty years of teaching and research and administrative experience, she is one of the leading Indian experts on contemporary Europe, EU, Germany and India with a focus on domestic and foreign and security policy. She also works on regional integration and organization, emerging powers, international politics, global governance, norms and peace and conflict resolution and higher education.
