The Centre has been offering Portuguese language courses as part time optional component since its inception. These courses have helped a large number of students, researchers and scholars who have been working in the broad areas of Latin American and Indo-Portuguese Studies. To foster academic cooperation with Portugal, the Centre signed an MoU with the Instituto Camoes of Portugal in 2007, which has immensely benefited our students and scholars.

The Centre also offers courses in Luso-Brazilian Studies. Several students of M.Phil completed their research on topics related to Brazilian literature and culture.
