CIRCULAR

The Executive Council in its 294th Meeting held on 26/03/2021 vide item No. 5.23 resolved to approve the Minutes of the meeting held on 08.03.2021 regarding various IHA/Hostel related issues as under:


1. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, it was decided by the University to give online 'Hostel No dues' to the terminal students who were unable to come University to vacate their allotted hostel room/s subject to an undertaking by the student/s that they will vacate their allotted hostel room/s within seven days from the opening of the University. However, many of these students have not vacated their allotted room/s yet.

The hostel administration should send letters to these students and ask them to vacate their allotted hostel room/s so that the same may be allotted to the other students.

2. Allotment of hostels to the students who were permitted to enter in the University Campus in phases.
 - (i) The double seater hostel rooms may be allotted to the Ph.D. students who were allowed to enter in the University Campus in Phases.
 - (ii) The hostel rooms may be allotted to PWD students, including new admission, as per rules.
 - (iii) The Dormitory may be allotted to the students of final semester of all Master programmes (admitted in A.Y. 2019-20) and to the M.Phil. final semester students who are supposed to submit their dissertations by 30th June, 2021.
 - (iv) Single Seater rooms may be allotted after opening of the University for all Ph.D. students.
 - (v) These allotments should be made as per Hostel Manual and in compliance of COVID-19 guidelines.
3. The following temporary arrangements may be made from Monsoon Semester 2021 till a separate hostel building is constructed for the students of School of Engineering:
 - i. The Damodar Hostel may be allotted to the First year and Second year students of School of Engineering. The third year students of the School of Engineering may be shifted to the other hostels.

- ii. During this temporary arrangement, normal hostel fees as prescribed for other students (except students of ABVSME), may be charged from the students of School of Engineering.
 - iii. The hostel will also be allotted to these students as per other students according to Hostel Manual and, hence, P-III category students are not eligible for hostel accommodations.
 - iv. If seats are available in Damodar Hostel, after allotment of hostel to the 1st and 2nd year students of School of Engineering, the same may be allotted temporarily to the other students for one semester.
 - v. The singly seater rooms of Damodar hostel may be allotted to the Ph.D. researchers as per Hostel Manual.
4. The working days/hours for permanent sanitation and mess workers would have no change and will remain 05 days a week as per present practice. However, 02 days weekly off will be given on roster/rotation basis instead of Saturday and Sunday to all sanitation and mess workers. The roster for weekly off may be prepared by the In-Charge of the concerned department/hostel.
