- 1. CDSL and NSDL both the agencies shortlisted by the UGC/MHRD for NAD implementation at universities/institutes were invited to give the presentation on their solution offering to JNU. Both the agencies presented their solution & proposals before the committee. - 3. The comparative statement of the responses received from both the agencies are enclosed herewith at Annexure - I.

The committee after detailed scrutiny and deliberations found that CVL NAD (CDSL) may be considered for the implementation of NAD at JNU based on the thoroughly evaluation of both the agencies' proposals and also on the lowest rates quoted. Hence, committee recommended CVL NAD (CDSL) for NAD implementation at JNU.
