



Application for award of Jawaharlal Nehru Young Leaders Fellowship under the Ryoichi Sasakawa Young Leaders Fellowship Fund [SYLFF] Programme for the academic year 2023-2024.

A. OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE OF THE PROGRAMME

The objective of the Program is to support the education of students enrolled in doctoral degree Programmes in the Schools and Centres of Humanities and Social Sciences [School of Social Sciences, School of International Studies, Schools of Languages, Literature & Culture Studies, School of Arts & Aesthetics, School of Sanskrit and Indic Studies, Special Centre for the Study of Law and Governance, Special Centre for Disaster Research, Special Centre for National Security Studies, Special Centre for the Study of North East India and Special Centre for Tamil Studies]. It is aimed at identifying and encouraging students with high potential for leadership in national, regional and international affairs, in public life as well as in private endeavors, by awarding fellowships. These fellowships will be awarded to outstanding Ph. D. students in Social Sciences and Humanities whose studies focus on the theme, 'Historical and Contemporary Perspective on the Social-Economics, Political and Cultural Dimensions of Human Development'.

Note: Minimum eligibility for considering the applicant he/she should be a confirmed Ph. D. student with an approved Ph. D. topic and has an assigned a guide and should be registered as a continuing Ph. D. student for the next semester. The candidate should have at least two years remaining period of his/her study in the Ph. D. programme as on the last date of receipt of application fellowship.
